We send you our warm Christian greetings and hope you are all well.

We are happy to report that we had a very busy summer with our regular monthly deliveries of food and clothing as well as preparing for our largest ever school backpack distribution programme. A very generous donor in the USA (who would like to remain anonymous) had 10,000 school backpacks made up and shipped to Israel, for children whose families could not afford to purchase them. These school backpacks were delivered or collected by many outreaches and municipalities around Israel. What a joy to know that some disadvantaged children would begin their school year prepared like all their other 'better-off' school classmates, fully equipped in respect of the protection of their school books. This helps to avoid unnecessary and unkind critical comments from other children of 'betteroff' parents. We wish to express our grateful thanks to this generous donor in the USA for going to the trouble and expense of organising and shipping these school backpacks which have all been distributed to children in great need.

It is estimated that as many as 90% of residents and 70% of all children in Sderot suffer from PTSD. We were extremely grateful to have an opportunity to help these dear people. Thank you for your prayers and financial support for this community and thank you also for empowering us to deliver this much needed help to these desperate folk.

We would also like to thank you for enabling us, to share with the street people in Tel Aviv. It's so good for them to have a place to go to receive a loving welcome, counselling and enjoy wholesome food as they navigate through the difficulties in their lives.

We have also had some busy weeks bringing food to those in great poverty before the High Holy Days in the Jewish calendar. We do our best to make sure they can celebrate so we add a few festive elements to our deliveries. These last few weeks we had been able to deliver food to Rishon L'Tsion, Ariel, Kfar Saba, Arad/Be'er Sheva, Bat Yam, and Hadera.

In addition to this because you have been helping us, we were able to supply a large quantity of <u>nappies</u> to the Crisis Pregnancy Centre in Tel Aviv.

We are now preparing to bring food and clothing again to needy folk in Haifa.

Thanks again to all Siloam supporters who have helped us provide for these dear people we are privileged to minister to with the practical love of Jesus Christ.
