Choose your mode of combat and fight slavery!

1. Pray

It's the powerful starting point for every great battle.



2. Write/email/text/twitter

Whether you choose pen and paper or electronic means, you can write to political figures and other policy makers. Public opinion shapes policy. You can find out about issues by contacting CAST, Anti-Slavery International or other human rights organisations. Some provide sample letter content.

3. Phone

You can 'phone around to engage with issues such as ethical shopping. For example, you can ask supermarkets in your area whether they sell only ethically sourced cotton. Those with sound business practices should know about the forced child and adult labour in the Uzbek cotton industry.





4. Shop

Every time you choose to buy an item which is based on ethical labour, you protect human rights and help to fight slavery. You need to be informed and many retailers provide shopping information. CAST has relevant projects and entire organisations like Traidcraft, the Fairtrade Foundation and the Leprosy Mission are trying to protect vulnerable people.

5. Sponsor

Globally, children and teenagers as well as adults are at risk of slavery. For as little as £10 a month, you can help sponsor a vulnerable child or teenager through Siloam Christian Ministries.

6. Enlist

Since biblical times, God has used His people acting together for His purposes. Church focus groups and events like Freedom Festivals can successfully oppose slavery. Please contact us at CAST to join those of us who want to be like Jesus and set captives free.
