Back in 2023, the Health Authorities in Ghana requested that we replaced the existing beds which had served the clinic for many years with new hygienic comfortable beds together with new mattresses. We were successful in purchasing with your help **25 hospital beds** by the end of 2023.



A Mindray Watco EX20 anaesthesia machine / vaporiser (ISOFLURANE). This is the most expensive component of the new operating theatre equipment which cost £6,664.00 and which I am pleased to tell you, has already been paid for by one generous donor. Praise God!

## Dear Siloam investing friends

We praise God that by the middle of June this year, we have raised £11,000 for our appeal to upgrade the Siloam Gospel Clinic to that of the Siloam Gospel Hospital. And, we are thankful that we have £5,400 leftover from 2024 so this means that we have presently £16,400 ready to be invested now in this upgraded medical facility so desperately needed in the southwest corner of Ghana.

So, we only need another £7,440 to completely cover the cost of our upgrade and we are really grateful that so many generous supporters and investors have identified with this particular need at a time when there are many other needful and valid needs in the world which desperately need funds.

I am so grateful that many supporters have been encouraged and motivated to support us by visualising and identifying with an individual piece of hospital equipment which they have fully funded. It was particularly encouraging to have the most expensive piece of equipment, the Mindray Watco EX20 anaesthesia machine / vaporiser, provided for during the first week of our appeal!! This was made possible by a faithful Siloam donor who wanted to honour her late sister who was formerly an anaesthetist in a UK hospital. How wonderful to empathise with a need in this way and make it an opportunity to honour a loved one who has sadly passed away. Other gifts that we have received have also been equated with a particular piece of equipment and I am pleased to learn that many of you could relate with what your donation / investment could actually purchase for this needy project in Ghana.

However, I do know that others have not been so motivated as they would have been by say, the image of a desperately sick child in a war zone. But, Siloam can only help in areas of the world where it is safe for our workers to go and make a meaningful difference.



A full blood count Haematology Analyser is required to enable the surgeon to get detailed information about each patient's blood before conducting surgery. This piece of equipment has also been paid for by another generous donor providing £3,465. – Thank you Lord Jesus!


