The challenge of 2022 -A NEW ROOF for the Siloam Gospel Clinic – Ghana

Dear faithful Siloam friends and investors

Raising money for roofs can be a thankless and daunting task unless the good reasons for doing so can be clearly conveyed. In the past, Siloam has raised funds for a replacement roof for the Rehoboth children's home in the Philippines for which our supporters provided a total of £22,000 in 2016, well over our average annual giving of £13,000 per year.

This autumn I want to invite you to help Siloam embrace the challenge to raise £16,770 to put a new roof on a much-valued medical facility in Ghana, West Africa, serving a remote population in Bonyere and 11 other nearby towns with a total population of 38,500. The reason this clinic needs to be kept open and functional is so that patients don't have to walk more than 121/2 miles for urgent medical treatment to another facility.

The Ghanian government is really highly embarrassed concerning the shortfall of the nation's medical care because as much as 40% of the medical work undertaken in Ghana is done by charities and missions who are held in high regard. It's sad also to learn that the clinic staff often have to wait for months for their salaries from the overstretched N.H.I.S and have to seek local subsidies to be able to provide for their own families.

The Siloam Gospel Clinic currently employs 38 members of staff to reach out to the local rural population. The departments include an outpatient, in-patient with 26 bed capacity, emergency, dispensing, pharmacy, maternity equipment with ultrasound, an investigative laboratory and a department specialising in reproductive and child's health. Surgery has to be undertaken by visiting doctors as the clinic cannot afford at the present time to provide proper accommodation for a resident doctor; that will be a future Siloam challenge. There is also general administration to be taken care of and medical records to be kept and the accounts department which look after the payments

made by N.H.I.S to reimburse the clinic's claims for

Meeting the challenge of 2021!



With the help of Siloam supporters last year, a new 30 KVA Perkins electric generator was purchased in May 2021 with a ministry gift grant from Siloam of £9,000.



Also in August 2021, Siloam supporters in the UK provided £4,300 to purchase the material and equipment to provide a waste incinerator that will dispose of dangerous clinic waste and 'sharps' used in the clinic's medical ministry.

This internal damage is the result of seasonal heavy rain that has damaged the ageing roof.

Damage like this inside starts slowly and unless the problem above it can be resolved, it will only get worse which means that equipment and furniture are at risk of damage.

Inside the building a repair contractor points out the damage caused internally by the leaking roof.



Addressing the urgent challenge to fund a NEW ROOF for the Siloam Gospel Clinic in Ghana.

Each roofing sheet will cost £15.60 to replace and 450 are required. Altogether £7,020 will be required for the corrugated roofing sheets alone!

The current challenge for 2022 is to urgently provide funds to repair the extensive roof of the clinic being shown here by the contractor.

Over the 20 years that the clinic has operated much has been done to patch up various leaks but these are really only like sticking plasters.

JUST VISUALISE WHAT YOUR DONATION COULD PAY FOR

- £1,000 could provide 161 6" x 2" roofing beams
- £ 500 would pay for 32 sheets of corrugated roofing
- £ 100 will cover the cost of 5½ boxes of nails
- £ 50 will be enough for 7 ceiling boards
- £ 25 would provide 4 6" x 2" roofing beams
- £ 15 will pay for one tin of heat reflecting roof paint

We need 12 gifts of £130 just to pay for the carpenter's labour charge
